Rio de la Plata, which means River of Silver in English, is an estuary. Do you
know what an estuary is.



If youve' been to a river, you know rivers flow. The water in a river move. At the ends of a river, this water
pours into an ocean. River water is fresh, which means it has no salt. Ocean water is very salty. Sometimes, when
a river meet an ocean, the ocean is strongest. This means that instead of river water pouring into the ocean, salty
ocean water pushes into a river. This is called an estuary. The Rio de la Plata estuary is very big and very muddy.

On one side of the Rio de la Plata is Montevideo. On the other side is Buenos Aires, the capital of Argentina.
There is a ferry boat that crosses the Rio de la Plata. This ferry carries people between Buenos Aires and
Montevideo.

Montevideo is a wonderful city. Like the rest of Uruguay, it isnt' very big. But there are many great places in
Montevideo. There is a building that were once a railway station. Today, this huge building houses several

restaurants. It is called Mercado del Puerto. There, you may buy a great steak and hear local music.

The steaks you can get at Mercado del Puerto are huge! In Uruguay people eat, on average, more than 100 pounds of beef each year! In addition to being a national favorite, beef is big business in Uruguay. In this country of sprawling pastures and relatively few people, cows outnumber people almost 4:1! Uruguay takes pride in its beef and is known for having some of the higher quality beef in the world. Uruguay has developed a nationalized tracking system for its cattle industry. Each animal is tracked from birth through slaughter, processing, and delivery. Uruguayan cattle are 100% grass-fed and never received hormones or antibiotics. This makes Uruguayan beef highly desirable to upscale markets around the world.

Uruguay is also known for its many beaches. Many people from all over the world visit Uruguay for its beaches. Some of the world's richest people love to vacation on Uruguay's beaches. This is because the beaches are so pretty.

From its beach to its rivers and its beef, Uruguay is a great country. It is one of South America's smallest. It is also one of South America's least populated. Uruguay is an amazing place.
