

"It's a Secret"

You'll need: Nothing

For: Two players—designate one as the "hand speaker" (will only communicate with a hand) and the other as the "guesser."

To do: Decide on an appropriate range (1-10 or 1-20).



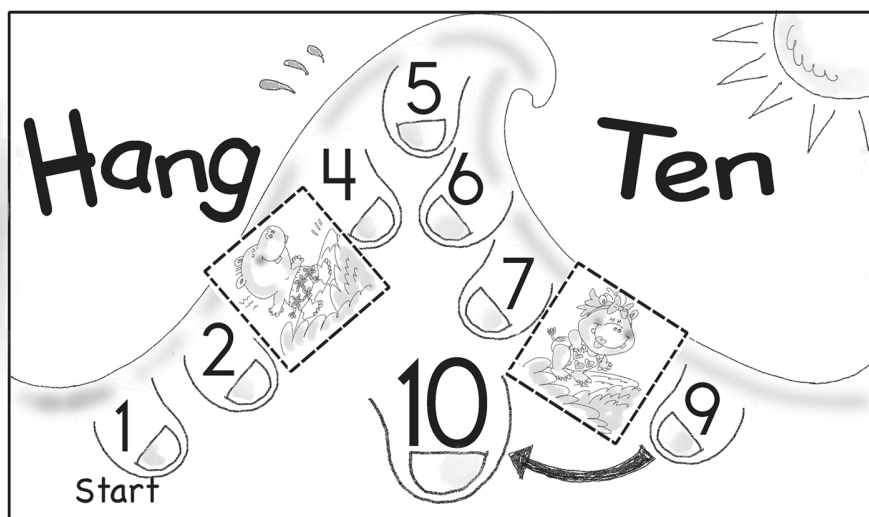
Have the hand speaker write down the "secret" number. The guesser should say a number. The speaker will then point up or down or move his/her hand sideways to indicate "almost" (if guess is within 2 numbers). Game continues until the guesser says the secret number.

"Hang Ten"

You'll need: Game board, game pieces,
(all included), two dice

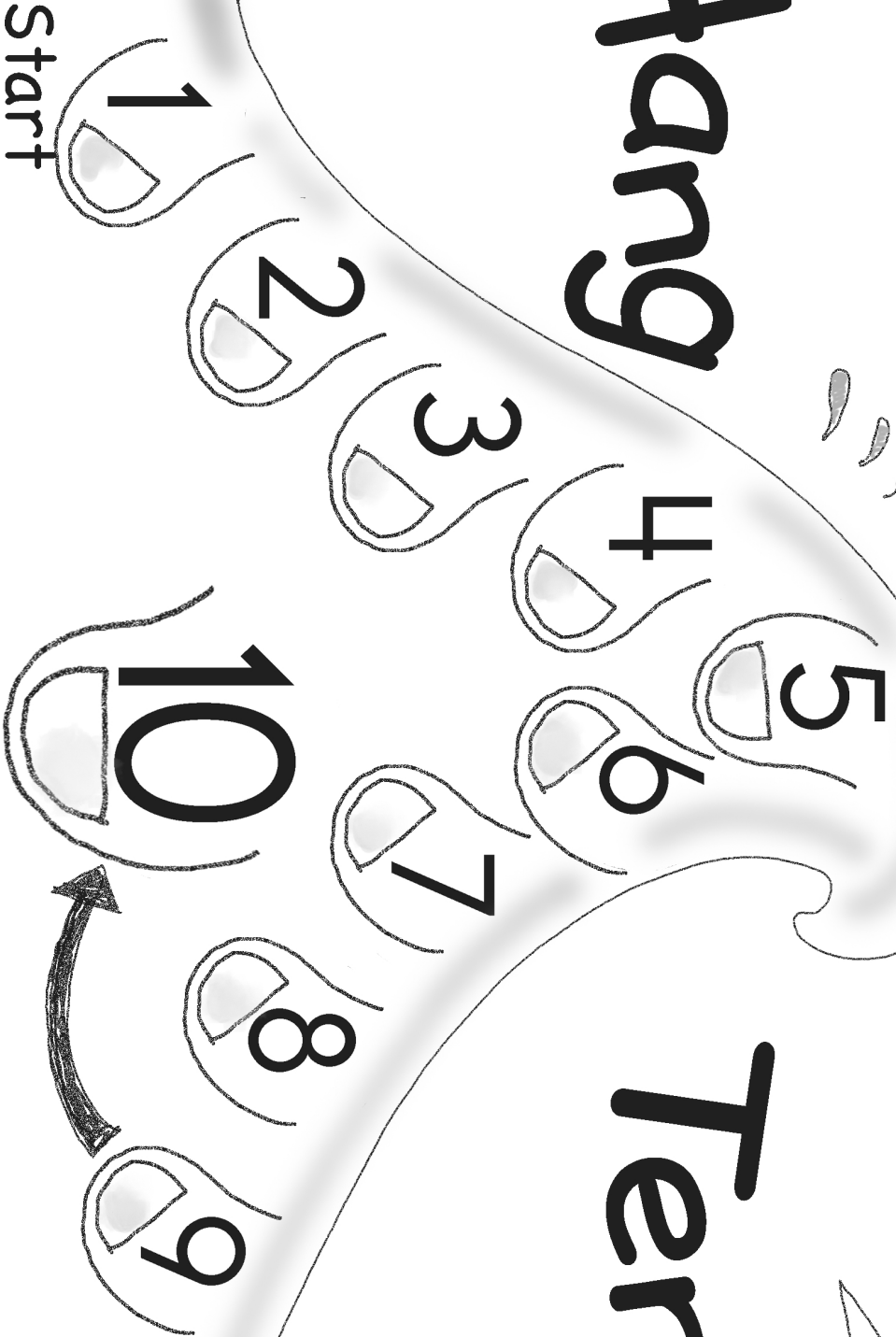
For: Two players

To do: Decide who will play first. Then...
For the first half of the board (1-5) the
player rolls 1 die. Players must proceed
one number at a time. For the second half
of the board (6-10), the players roll 2 dice.
Players must roll the exact number and
move in the exact numerical order. If
not, they don't move. The player who
moves onto the number 10 first wins.

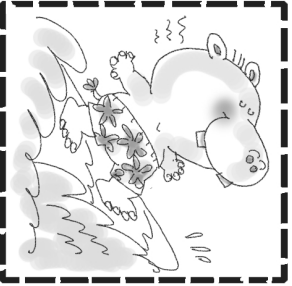
