

## Opening Day







Today is the first day of the Winter Olympic Games for Animals. The snow leopards from Afghanistan are leading the parade.




Right behind them are the Wild Asian buffaloes from Bhutan.




China's Tibetan antelopes are third. They will compete in the Cross County Ski event.




The luge team from Denmark is next. The Eurasian otters are really excited to be at the Olympics!




The tiny European minks are right behind the otters. They are from France. They are figure skaters.




A Bactrian camel from Mongolia is next. He will be in the Skeleton.




Ten Russian tigers are following the Bactrian camel.
